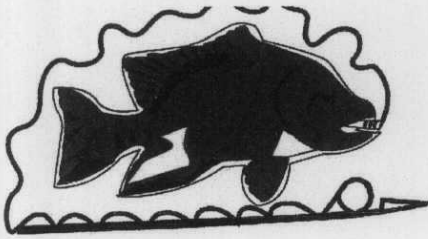

BY-LAWS UPDATED(AGM 2011)

- 1. The Annual General Meeting shall be held in November each year to elect the executive committee.**
- 2. The Sub-Committee can consist of Vice-President, Vice-Captain, Assistant Secretary, Publicity Officer, Assistant Treasurer and Assistant Social Secretary. If the Executive Committee deems a sub-committee member inactive, he or she may be replaced.**
- 3. Fees shall become due by the 30th September each year.**
- 4. The Club shall be dissolved in the event of the membership being less than three (3) persons. Any assets and monies on hand (should the club be dissolved) and after payment of all expenses and liabilities, shall be handed over to the Volunteer Marine Rescue Hervey Bay Inc.**
- 5. Social events must be available to all members. The cost of these may be met by members participating or may be subsidized partly or fully by the club.**
- 6. Club members must contact the Secretary by the due date for all social events or they will not be considered for same.**

- 7. Club competition will close at the end of September each year.**
- 8. Presentation Night shall be held in November each year.**
- 9. The club does not accept any responsibility for any member or their visitor or their gear whilst on any fishing trip or other club activity.**
- 10. The Club Captain, if unable to attend any outing, may appoint a Trip Captain for that outing.**
- 11. Any member found contravening Club By-Laws shall lose all points accrued for the year.**
- 12. New member nomination forms must be in hands of secretary for approval at next meeting.**
- 13. New members joining the club on or after September shall be deemed financial until the end of the following year.**
- 14. Yearly trophies to be awarded to senior men, senior women, overall junior, overall sub-junior, and all divisions.**
- 15. Honorary memberships may be offered to persons of some status in the community who have rendered valuable service or support to the Hervey Bay Amateur Fishing Club Inc. Memberships to be approved and received at any General Meeting. The list will remain selective and will always be a small ratio as compared to ordinary memberships. Such memberships shall not in itself confer voting rights.**
- 16. Life Membership may be offered on a selected basis to persons who have rendered particularly valuable and continuous service or support to the Hervey Bay Amateur Fishing Club Inc. with the length of such service or support after a period of seven (7) years. Awarding of Life Membership to be limited to one (1) Life Member every two (2) years and will confer voting rights. Written nominations must be presented in a sealed envelope to a member of the Executive Committee and be approved by members at a General Meeting. Awards to be presented at the club's Annual Banquet.**
